COAL PREP "101"

CPSA's Flagship course is now offered in a condensed format as a one day workshop. CPSA is pleased to be able to host the next workshop in conjunction with the Midwest Coal Prep Society at the Double Tree Hotel Downtown Evansville, Indiana on Friday, October 8, 2021 from 8AM to 4PM.

Registration can be done on our website listed below. A continental breakfast, lunch and refreshments will be provided. All for just \$99.99 for members and \$149.99 for non-members (which includes a 1 year membership).

The workshop will be led by Dr. Rick Honaker from the University of Kentucky. It will earn 8 Professional Development Hours and is designed as an overview for anyone involved in coal preparation from operators to application engineers.



The workshop will provide an introduction to the importance of coal preparation on the economics of a mining operation, identify the process units commonly used for particle sizing, coal cleaning and dewatering, discuss typical process flowsheets and provide operational guidelines for maintaining optimum plant and process unit efficiency.

Starting with background information that describes (i) why coal preparation is necessary, (ii) methods for determining coal cleanability, and (iii) what types of plant layouts are required, topics to be covered in the workshop include:

- sizing operations (screens, sieves and classifying cyclones),
- cleaning operations (dense medium separators, water-based separators, and froth flotation),
- and dewatering operations (centrifugal dryers, screenbowl centrifuges, vacuum filters, belt presses, and thickeners).
